- A recognised qualification in child psychotherapy, psychology, counselling, family therapy or equivalent. Social workers with clinical experience are welcome to apply
- Have an understanding of trauma and attachment focused models of practice
- A commitment to being part of a supportive and dynamic interdisciplinary team
- Experience of working in the area of sexual abuse would be preferable
