Adolescent Service

The STOP Adolescent Service provides assessment and intervention for adolescent males aged 12-18 years who are motivated to stop their harmful sexual behaviour.

The service is community based and provides an individualised intervention that incorporates individual, group and family/whānau intervention.

How to Refer

Referrals are accepted from Oranga Tamariki, Ministry for Vulnerable Children. In Canterbury there are also limited spaces for referrals from schools, health and community professionals, counsellors and the Police.
